President's Message....

After a lot of discussion, hopefully waiting for a better outcome, the board of Directors has reluctantly agreed that it is in the best interest and well being of our membership to not start up our chapter meetings in person this September. Instead, we are planning to resume those meetings in a virtual format via Zoom. The BOD has continued to meet via Zoom since March and it's a pretty effective tool and simple to use. We plan to keep the meetings pretty much the same format with a

guest speaker each month. More details will be provided in a separate communication.

October is our annual meeting when we vote on chapter business. Two items up for vote are 1) elections and 2) approval for an updated version of our bylaws.

According to our bylaws, officers are elected to two year terms and board members to three year terms. Because the board could not recall having reelected directors between three year terms, we decided to put them all on the ballot for reelection to be in compliance with our bylaws. Going forward, we will be more diligent in tracking the terms of board members and putting them up for reelection at the end of their terms. The following is the list those running for reelection. Please contact me or any one of the board members if you are interested in joining to help out in any capacity. We always welcome new people into the board. The influx of new people and ideas is critical to the future of the chapter. Note that we have two very critical open positions that we must fill. Ray Schaefer is stepping down as Vice President and Steve Gerling is stepping down as Conservation Chair. Both plan to remain on the board and continue serving the chapter.


